PROJECT DESCRIPTION

As you are aware, proper pool care is essential in order to achieve a healthy and inviting swimming environment. In addition, public pools often mean high usage which makes it imperative to monitor and manage the various water levels. Correct pH levels are imperative to keep your pools free from algae and for maintaining sparkling water. Many things can occur without proper pool care and water balance such as plaster surface etching, green and murky pool water, black algae, etc.

The scope of this bid includes the provision of the necessary pool chemicals required to care for all 11 pools owned and maintained by the City of Aspen Falls. The volumes and costs provided here are adequate supplies for the care and maintenance of all 11 pools for the entire summer (end of May – beginning of September). Insert text before September

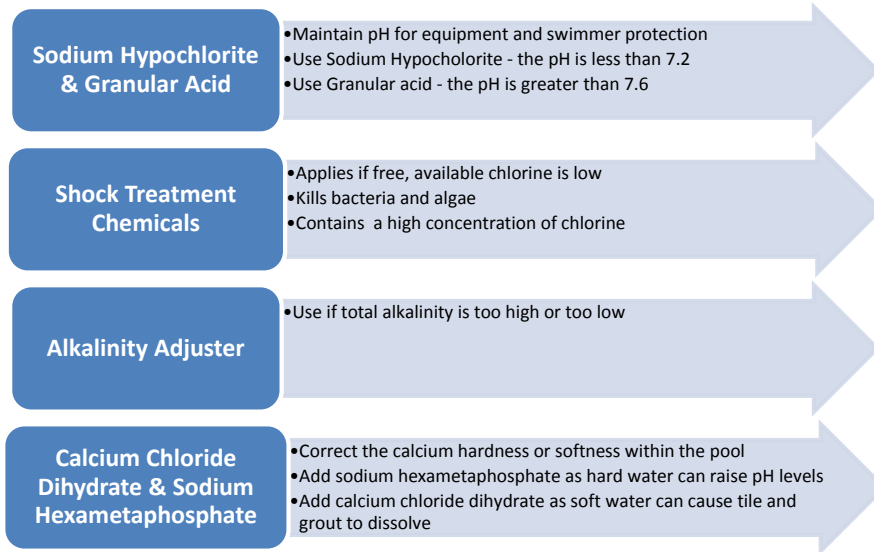

As a service to the City of Aspen Falls, RCW Pool and Spa is offering free water testing for all the city pools both prior to opening of the pools and ongoing on a weekly basis.

RCW Pool and Spa recommends weekly treatment of pools with at least one shock treatment per month and weekly pH level testing. The necessary chemicals to properly care for all 11 pools are listed in the services provided section. Based on the recommended treatment, RCW Pool and Spa bids this project at \$12,000 for the summer plus free weekly water testing. This cost includes sufficient supplies needed to care for all 11 pools. Additionally, you may return any unused chemicals at the end of the summer for a credit for the following year or reimbursement for unused portions.

When the bid is presented to the City of Aspen Falls, a formal acceptance of the bid occurs and the Agreement is signed.

RCW Pool and Spa looks forward to the potential of working with the City of Aspen Falls. We would like to set up some time to discuss this bid and answer questions or provide additional information that is needed.
