- The post-secondary evening held in February was fully attended. Parents and students from the area's high schools attended a lively presentation about career and educational opportunities.
- Staff meetings are organized around specific themes. The theme of the February staff meeting was the recent anti-bullying survey that showed where in the facility bullying of school-age visitors occurs. The changing rooms and the lower washrooms were the most at-risk areas. More facility staff in halls and stairways and more checking of washrooms and outside areas around the building is helping to control bullying.
